



PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

Parade will be JULY 3, 2010 at Noon on Main Street

Parade line-up FOR ALL NON-WALKING ENTRIES, will be at the WOOL BOWL'S parking lot, (west side).

Parade line-up FOR ALL WALKING ENTRIES, will be in the parking lot at the corner of N. Main St. & College St. (southwest corner).

The parade will commence promptly at NOON, at the corner of N. Main & College Streets. All entries must be in place by 11:00 a.m. Parade will continue down Main St. to Alameda St.

This event is for the primary purpose of entertaining the crowd & keeping it safe! It goes without saying that no entries will be allowed to participate should the Superintendent, in his/her sole discretion, decide that said entry is offensive, divisive, or otherwise inappropriate. The safety of the parade participants is also important and the Superintendent reserves the right to reject/remove any entry due to safety concerns.

No entries shall exceed 60 feet in total length, 20 feet in total width and 14 feet 6 inches in height.

No entry shall allow a participant to ride on the hood, trunk, back or roof of any vehicle, or the sides of the bed of a pickup truck.

All entries carrying children MUST have an adult riding with them at all times.

All entries involving animals MUST have "pooper scoopers" following them.

ABSOLUTELY NO CANDY, TRINKETS OR OTHER OBJECTS ARE TO BE THROWN FROM ANY ENTRY!!!!

Walkers may accompany an entry to hand out candy, trinkets, or other objects, to the crowd.

HOWEVER, they may not dismount and remount an entry.

All floats/entries should be constructed of flame resistant materials.

All floats must carry a fire extinguisher of at least 2-A 10-BC capacity.

All entries are subject to on-sight inspection by the Roswell Fire Department, the Roswell Police Department, or other appropriate authority.

THE DIRECTIONS OF PARADE STAFF ARE TO BE FOLLOWED BY ALL ENTRIES AT ALL TIMES - NO EXCEPTIONS!

Neither the parade sponsors nor the parade staff is responsible for any accident involving injury to any person or property associated with the parade.

All entries must be submitted by **4 p.m., July 2, 2010**. No entries will be permitted after the deadline.

PARADE PRIZE/TROPHY CATAGORIES

Theme is: "Aliens in Cinema"

FLOATS

- Best use of Theme (Aliens In Cinema)
- Best Animated (Human or Mechanical)
- Most Original
- Crowd Favorite (Chosen by crowd or float participants at the staging area.)
- Grand Prize/Best Overall Float (Chosen from winners of above 4 categories.)

NON-FLOATS/OTHERS

- Best Alien (Walking or riding on a trailer or in the bed of a truck.)
- Best UFO (***Self-Propelled**)
- Best Performing Group (Walking or riding on a trailer or in the bed of a truck.)
- Best Performing Individual (Walking or riding on a trailer or in the bed of a truck.)
- Judges Favorite/Grand Prize (Chosen from the winners of the above 4 categories.)

***UFO, must be self-propelled by any means, such as human feet, a bicycle, a golf cart, an old car (that doesn't smoke), a tesla coil, a back-engineered anti-grav., a warp drive, etc. All UFO'S riding on trailers or in the bed of a truck will be judged as a float.**

All performing entries will be limited to 90 seconds, while performing for the judges. Please keep in mind, this is a parade and that the crowd will expect it to keep moving. Time limitations will be strictly enforced. "Performers Timing" will begin when all performers have come to a stop in front of the judges and signal "ready to begin". At the conclusion of your performance, please continue along the parade route to the end point. All winners will be announced following the parade at the Judges Stand in front of the Community Civic Center.
